On Railroad Mills Road in Ontario County, the Sanctuary is a 30 acre wildflower and forest preserve with a clubhouse and many hiking trails. The Burroughs Audubon Nature Club, an Educational Corporation, was organized in 1913 by William Hoot and chartered by the NYS Board of Regents. The purpose of the organization is the promotion of natural science, participation in local, state and national conservation projects, and the encouragement of the study of ornithology, botany, entomology, and of nature in general.
